GUIDANCE TO PARENTS FOR SCHOOL FIXTURES

The school and its staff have a duty of care towards their pupils and as such need to be informed if any arrangements are made that are outside the expected procedures explained below.

The boys travel to the away fixture on the school minibus, play the game, have 'team tea' and return by minibus to the school.

Expectations of pupils and parents at all school fixtures

Punctuality:

Fixture dates and times are included in the school calendar and departure times from the school detailed on the website team sheets.

Travel:

For an away fixture the school must be informed if you are travelling independently. This notification should be made the day before and preferably in writing.

At the end of away fixtures boys are free to go home with their parents but they must inform the member of staff before they leave.

Boys should not travel home with adults other than their parents, without their own parent's permission.

Boarders' parents must contact the boarding house in advance if they are not returning to school after a midweek fixture.

Boys must wear school uniform (excluding caps) unless otherwise directed.

The Match:

Boys must ensure that their games kit is clean and that they have all the equipment they need.

As representatives of the school they should be on their best behaviour at all times and show good sportsmanship on the games field.

Parents are to support their children and the opposition in a positive and encouraging fashion.

Boys are expected to stay for 'team teas' after the game.
