### **BOARDING AIMS**

At Moulsford, we aim to:

- Develop the whole person.
- Produce an open and trusting ethos in which each boarder feels able to approach any other member of the community (boarder or staff member), confident in the knowledge that they will be treated and respected as an individual.
- Create an atmosphere of tolerance, openness and trust in which teasing, harassment and bullying would find great difficulty in developing.
- Provide the conditions for boarders to develop their intellectual talents through well-structured prep conditions, access to staff and others pupils, participation in activities and in an atmosphere which values effort.
- Provide a range of activities, hobbies and opportunities that will assist in the personal and social development of each boarder
- Safeguard and promote the welfare of each boarder, by providing an environment that is, as far as possible, free from physical hazards and dangers of any sort.
- Provide accommodation that is comfortable and suited to the needs of the boarders, and provides adequate levels of privacy.
- Develop boarders' responsibility for self, for others and their belongings.
- Encourage boarders' to contribute to the needs and welfare of others in the house and school.
- Provide suitable conditions for boarders to feel able to turn to members of staff to share the good things in their lives, as well as seeking advice, counselling and support during times of difficulty.
